

Pro-Israel PACs Pour Money into Elections

The American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) made unwelcome headlines this year by inadvertently exposing members of Congress, the Trump administration, activists and convention center workers to the coronavirus during their conference, held from Feb. 28 to March 2 in Washington, DC. While AIPAC's 2021 conference has been cancelled for fear of hosting another "Super Spreader," that hasn't slowed its work directing contributions and politicians to help Israel.

During the primaries pro-Israel PACs and Super-PACs spread bundles of cash around to deserving candidates across the country. Funds found their way into the campaigns of 41 first-time recipients. Expect those totals to multiply in the last weeks before the November elections.

Super PACs can legally hide their donors and spend unlimited money independently on ads, direct mail and other extras as long as the cash doesn't go directly into a candidate's campaign. Super PAC funds aren't reported to the Federal Election Commission and so we can't track them (yup, that's the point) in the following pages. Readers can still get an idea about who is getting the really big bucks by reading the following pages.

While pro-Israel groups poured money into the campaign coffers of challengers to the "Squad," young, largely female progressive candidates of color it didn't work! Rep. Ilhan Omar (D-MN) trounced her challenger Antone Melton-Meaux, who received more than 90 percent of his \$4.1 million from pro-Israel PACs while Omar's \$4.2 million came from mostly small donors. A new pro-Israel super PAC, Americans for Tomorrow's Future, spent over \$2 million attacking Omar.

Another progressive candidate, Jamaal Bowman, unseated Rep. Eliot Engel (D-NY), a 16-term Jewish veteran congressman and the chairman of the powerful House Foreign Affairs Committee. Engel has been at the top of our list of career recipients of pro-Israel funds for years. The final results, announced July 17, showed a humiliating loss for Engel, who won 40 percent of the vote to Bowman's 55 percent. The Super PAC Democratic Majority for Israel funded a controversial television attack ad against Bowman, but voters kept their wits.

Rep. Rashida Tlaib, a BDS supporter, easily won her primary in Michigan's 13th district. Missouri's Cori Bush, another progressive activist prominent in the Black Lives Matter movement and a supporter of BDS, won her primary against another powerful incumbent, Rep. William Lacy Clay, Jr.

These candidates stood up to the lobby, won their primaries and will continue to push their party to the left on Middle East policy.
